General Re-Use Store

The Switzerland County ReUse Store is open from 12-5pm on Monday and Wednesday and from 8:00am – 12:00pm on Saturdays. Phone: 812.801.6549.

Building Materials Re-Use Store

This Re-Use store is available to the residents of Switzerland County. It is located at the Recycle Center in East Enterprise. Hours are: Mon. 1-6pm; Wed. 1-6 pm; Sat 8am-12pm.

WHAT WE DO

RECYCLING

- Staffs and maintains 8 Recycle Centers in the district
- Collects recyclables at 50 schools weekly
- Assists in 14 satellite recycling locations

EDUCATION

- Adult / Youth Education Presentations throughout the seven county district
- Annual Scholarship Program for high school seniors in district
- Provides Recycling Rebates to 50+ schools
- Quarterly recycling education publication distributed through schools / newspapers

RE-USE STORES

- Staffs and manages 7 ReUse Stores throughout the district
- Re-Use stores host over 1200 visitors weekly

GRANT PROGRAMS

- Recycling grants provided to the 9 communities offering curbside recycling
- Recycling grants provided for counties offering satellite recycling opportunities

COUNTY ASSISTANCE

- SISWD prepares trash / recycling bids & contracts for district cities, towns, counties
- SISWD assists counties in maintaining environmental compliance standards
- SISWD works with / supports area chambers, safety programs, local events, etc.

DISASTER DEBRIS ASSISTANCE

- SISWD assists all 7 counties in the removal of debris from disasters such as tornadoes, floods, ice storms, etc.
- SISWD prepares damage assessment volumes throughout the district to help communities in removal cost calculations
- SISWD is responsible for removal of difficult to dispose of items left in the wake of a disaster



LOCATIONS

The Recycle Center is located next to the Switzerland County Highway Garage on McCreary Ridge Road (just south of East Enterprise off Highway 56). Additional recycling opportunities in Switzerland County are located in Patriot and Moorefield behind the firehouses.

ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



PAPER PRODUCTS

- CORRUGATED CARDBOARD & PAPERBOARD
- NEWSPAPER
Must be dry.
- MIXED PAPER
Office, computer paper, junk mail. Keep dry.
- MAGAZINES
Includes softback & phone books. Keep dry.



GLASS

- GLASS BOTTLES
All glass food and beverage bottles: clear, green, brown. Please rinse.



PLASTIC BAGS

- Clean, dry plastic grocery bags. Also shrink wrap, dry cleaner bags, drink carton wraps.



PLASTICS #1 - #2

- PETE or #1 BOTTLES
Soft drink, soda, water bottles. Please rinse.
- HDPE or #2 BOTTLES.
Milk & juice jugs, detergent & bleach containers. Please rinse.



ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



BATTERIES

- CAR BATTERIES
Must not be cracked. Cells must be capped.
- RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES
Rechargeable batteries are accepted. Please no alkaline batteries.



METALS & ALUMINUM

- ALUMINUM
Soft drink and beer cans. Please rinse and separate from metal cans.
- STEEL / TIN
Food, soup, vegetables, etc. Please wash.
- SCRAP METAL
Remove gas tanks, fuels, batteries from appliances. No wire fencing.



FLUORESCENT BULBS

- Disposal of FLUORESCENT BULBS is free for residents. The fee for all businesses and organizations is \$1 per bulb.

The following items **will not** be accepted:

- Fuel tanks
- Household Hazardous Waste
- Window or plate glass
- Alkaline batteries

Please do not leave items after hours.



PROBLEM WASTES



REFRIGERANTS

- ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:
Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers. \$15 per unit.



ELECTRONICS

- COMPUTERS & MONITORS
- TELEVISIONS, STEREOS, DVD PLAYERS, PHONES, VCRs, PRINTERS, SCANNERS.

Electronic devices with a screen: \$15 per unit.



OIL, FILTERS, ANTIFREEZE

- LIMIT: 5 gallons of motor oil.



USED TIRES

- AUTO / PICK UP (Limit 10)
\$2 off rim. \$3 on rim.
- LARGE TRACTOR TIRE (Limit 4 total)
Off rim: \$20. On rim: \$25.
- SEMI TRUCK TIRES (Limit: 4)
\$6 off rim. \$10 on rim.
- SUPER SINGLE: \$10
- BOBCAT/LIFT/SKID STEER: \$3
- ATV: \$1

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE



HHW Disposal Opportunity
Accepted (at NO fee): Cleaning chemicals, oil based paints and stains, pesticides / herbicides, acids, fluorescent bulbs, flammables, mercury items, etc. **The date for the 2018 Summer HHW Disposal in Switzerland County is July 21 from 8am - 10am at the Recycle Center.**



PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE



Residents of Switzerland County may dispose of controlled and non-controlled medicines and sharps items at the Sheriff's Dept.

Free E-Waste Disposal Details

Free Electronics Disposal

During the week of August 6-11 residents of the Southeastern Indiana Recycling District may dispose of their screened electronics at NO CHARGE (typically a \$15 fee per device)!!! **Please note there is a disposal limit of 3 screened devices per household for the week.** (Any additional screened devices will be charged the standard \$15 per unit.)
