



**Please consider the following guidelines for usage of the center:**

- The Center is for use by the residents of Ripley and Franklin Counties only
- Batesville residents may drop off (during business hours) "difficult disposal" items such as tires, electronics, refrigerant bearing items, rechargeable and auto batteries, fluorescent bulbs, grocery bags.
- Standard recyclables may be dropped off inside the Recycle Center during business hours. Recyclable items need to be separated for placement in the labeled bins. This service is ONLY for the use of residents who DO NOT have curbside recycling available to them.
- TRASH is NOT to be placed in the recycling containers at any time. Security cameras are utilized to prevent abuse.
- Please obey all signage regarding traffic flow and parking at the center.
- Please note the non-acceptable and acceptable items for recycling listed in this brochure and on the containers.
- Please note the holiday closings listed in this brochure and posted in the facility.
- No recyclable materials are available for removal. Once material has been dropped off it is to remain in the facility and/or the containers.



**RECYCLING**

- Staffs and maintains 8 Recycle Centers
- Collects recyclables at 65 schools weekly
- Assists in 14 satellite recycling locations

**DIFFICULT DISPOSALS**

- Provides the opportunity for residents to dispose of "difficult" items that are potentially harmful to human health and our environment.
- Such items include: Household Hazardous Waste, Tires, Batteries, Automotive Oil/Fluids, Electronic Waste, Pharmaceutical Waste, Refrigerant Bearing Items, Mercury, etc.

**EDUCATION**

- Adult / Youth Education Presentations throughout the seven county district
- Annual Scholarship Program for high school seniors in district
- Quarterly recycling education publication distributed through schools / newspapers

**RE-USE STORES**

- Staffs and manages 7 ReUse Stores
- Re-Use stores host over 1200 visitors weekly

**GRANT PROGRAMS**

- Recycling grants provided to 11 communities offering curbside recycling and/or satellite recycling opportunities

**COUNTY ASSISTANCE**

- SISWD prepares trash / recycling bids & contracts for district cities, towns, counties
- SISWD assists counties in maintaining environmental compliance standards
- SISWD works with / supports area chambers, safety programs, local events, etc.

**DISASTER DEBRIS ASSISTANCE**

- SISWD assists all 7 counties in the removal of debris from disasters such as tornadoes, floods, ice storms, etc.
- SISWD prepares damage assessment volumes throughout the district to help communities in removal cost calculations.

## ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



### PAPER PRODUCTS

- CORRUGATED CARDBOARD  
Boxes should be broken down and flattened.
- MIXED PAPER  
The following items may be combined:  
Office, computer paper, junk mail, softback books, newspapers, magazines, paperboard (such as cereal boxes), phone books, etc.  
Please bag shredded paper.
- HARDBACK BOOKS  
Hardback books may be recycled. Please place in the appropriate bins for: Library or Textbook.



### PLASTIC BAGS

- Clean, dry plastic grocery bags. Also shrink wrap, dry cleaner bags, drink carton wraps.



### PLASTICS

- PETE or #1 BOTTLES  
Soft drink, soda, water bottles. Please rinse.
- HDPE or #2 BOTTLES / JUGS  
Milk & juice jugs, detergent & bleach containers. Please rinse.



## ACCEPTED RECYCLABLES



### BATTERIES

- CAR BATTERIES  
Must not be cracked. Cells must be capped.
- RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES  
Rechargeable batteries are accepted. Please no alkaline batteries.



### METALS & ALUMINUM

- ALUMINUM  
Soft drink and beer cans.
- STEEL / TIN  
Food, soup, vegetables, etc. Please rinse.



### GLASS

- GLASS BOTTLES  
All glass food and beverage bottles: clear, green, brown. Please rinse.



### FLUORESCENT BULBS

- Disposal of FLUORESCENT BULBS is free for residents. The fee for all businesses and organizations is \$1 per bulb.



## PROBLEM WASTES



### REFRIGERANTS

- ACCEPTABLE ITEMS INCLUDE:  
Refrigerators, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers. \$15 per unit.



### ELECTRONICS

- COMPUTERS & MONITORS
- TELEVISIONS, STEREOS, DVD PLAYERS, PHONES, VCRs, PRINTERS, SCANNERS.

Electronic devices with a screen: \$15 per unit.



### USED TIRES

- AUTO / LIGHT TRUCK (Limit 10)  
\$2 off rim. \$3 on rim.
- ATV: \$1

### PHARMACEUTICAL WASTE

#### Available Disposals



Ripley and Franklin Cty Health Departments accept sharps. Both controlled and non-controlled medications may be disposed of at the Franklin County Sheriff's Dept., the Ripley County Sheriff's Dept., Batesville Police Dept. or Margaret Mary Health.

The following items are **NOT** accepted:

- Household Hazardous Waste
- Window or plate glass
- Paper / Cardboard that is wet
- Alkaline batteries

**Please do not leave items after hours.**
